


Editor's Corner Josh Grosse

June has arrived! May had some bright and sunny days that transitioned 35 degrees, or more, with cold-weather gear needed in the mornings followed by hot-weather gear later in the day. I hope your riding season, like mine, is well underway.

Jim forwarded an update on the BMW Riders Association national rally. In summary, it's scheduled for September 14-17 in Davis, West Virginia, with tickets and information available from the BMW RA at https://bmwra.org/rally23/.

Jim also provided some details on the upcoming Where's Waldo ride, June 7:

Where's Waldo? you may ask. If you are new to the club you will want to know that Waldo is an annual destination for MCBeemers each year for a Fried Bologna Sandwich and Mile High Pie. This year we are going a little earlier than our normal Aug ride (which does not preclude a second trip). We will meet at the BP station in Monroe, MI at exit 15, on I75. Kickstands up at 9AM with a rest stop about half way. After Waldo, some will return to MI after lunch; some will continue on to other destinations. Brian B, Jay & Jim M will continue on to Thornville, OH for overnight lodging Wed-Fri while visiting the Hocking Hills State Park area and interesting riding in that area. Brian & Jim may return to MI on Saturday; while Jay may continue on to visit a friend in VA.





Jeff has planned the June lunch ride, which will be to Bullfrogs in Ortonville. He says, "Depart Triumph Detroit right on Van Dyke, left on 25 mile road, right on Mound, left on 32 mile road, right on Rochester road, left on Lakeville road, which turns into Seymour Lake road, left on Baldwin, right on Seymour Lake road and right on Ortonville road to Bullfrogs."

Jeff also attended the Distinguished Gentleman's Ride. He wrote:

The Distinguished Gentleman's Ride was amazing. 10 bikes left Triumph Detroit after coffee and doughnuts supplied by "JB" and his team. The M1 concourse was a great meeting spot and we each had our picture taken upon arrival, there were approximately 100 bikes present. All kinds and makes were represented and it was like a motorcycle show. Triumph, BMW, Harley Davidson, Indian, Honda, Royal Enfield, BSA, Janus and Moto Guzzi. A couple of pictures of the most unique are attached, 1967 Moto Guzzi Police Bike, Janus 450 hand made in Goshen Indiana and original unrestored Goldwing GL1000. The event raised over \$20,000 for Men's health awareness and prostate cancer research. A nice route was taken around Oakland County including a parade in Birmingham. It was very colorful with some unique attire and I noticed people along the route stopping to take pictures and smiling... good stuff and fun.
