# May 7th club ride - Rhys Blair

For those club members and attendees thinking about making the club ride on Saturday, May 7 here are a few details. I plan on leaving our favorite dealership no later than 11:30 a.m. I'd like to leave as early as 11:15 a.m. if possible. We'll make our way over to I-75 and go south across the Ohio border to I-280. South on I-280 to just below the I-80/90 interchange. There we'll go south on 420 to U.S.20. We then go east on U.S. 20 to southbound U.S. 23. We'll travel U.S. 23 south to Waldo, Ohio which is just south of Marion about 10 miles. I figure it to be about 180 miles or about 3.5 hours riding distance and time.

If you are planning on making this trip, arrive at the dealership with a full tank of gas and leave the dealership with an empty bladder. We probably won't eat until about 3:00 p.m. so you may want to eat more than donuts at the dealership Saturday morning.

After we eat and socialize a bit, I will be riding over to Lima, Ohio with Steve Penzcak to check out the fairgrounds where the National Rally is to be held this year in July. Steve is one of our members from Illinois and he and I will be remaining overnight in Lima before heading our separate ways on Sunday. The ride back should you not decide to go to Lima is straight up U.S. 23 to 15. West on 15 to I-75 and north on

I-75 to wherever you need to go.

Now some of you have never heard of Waldo and it's famous fried baloney sandwiches, and some of you have never ventured to Waldo to try one or two. The tavern in Waldo, there are only two, where we go for these tasty sandwiches have been written up on several occasions for their specialty food. The owner of the tavern makes about 1000 pounds of homemade bologna a week. He sells the majority of it as grilled sandwiches. The sandwich is made up of a quarter inch thick piece of grilled baloney which is then placed on a sesame seed bun, topped with onion and pickles and a slice of cheese. There is a whole menu board of items that are also made fresh daily from baloney too like baloney salad, to go with your chicken or egg salad sandwich. This is sort of like a retro type thing. It takes you back when you were a kid and you fried baloney up in a pan and served it between two pieces of soft white bread with Miracle Whip or Mustard. However, this slice of baloney won't curl up in the pan, no way. It is way too thick. The other thing I noticed and recommend is that this sandwich goes very well with a long neck Rolling Rock chaser. Try it just once and you to will be telling people about the time you drove 3 hours for a fried baloney sandwich in another state. Just watch and seel.

Steve and I first ran across this tavern on our way to southern Indiana one day when we had ventured out from South Bend on our way to a steak house somewhere close to the Kentucky/Indiana border. We had stopped for breakfast in a little town called Kokomo and while waiting for our food we read an article in Midwest Living about this tavern in Waldo and it's specialty. We decided then to hell with steaks we wanted fried baloney for dinner. We finished breakfast, mounted our Beemers and headed east at the very next traffic light. We arrived about 4:30 p.m. that Saturday having crossed half the states of Indiana and Ohio to get there. We parked our bikes and bellied up to the bar and ordered two sandwiches and two Rolling Rocks each. We polished them off, checked our watches and fuel and drove back to South Bend, Indiana all in the same day. That was some 15 years ago!



ESSEX JUNCTION, Vt. More than seven-thousand motorcycle enthusiasts and their families will be descending on Vermont next year.

Officials at the Champlain Valley Exposition say they will be hosting the 34th International Rally of B-M-W Motorcycle Owners of America in July of 2006.

The rally site rotates throughout North America. Last year it was held in Spokane, Washington, and will be in Lima, Ohio, this summer.

# Allen Gigliotti sends along this information on the 2005 class schedule

Basic Rider Course (BRC) A 15-18 hour Motorcycle Safety Foundation course for the inexperienced rider. Motorcycles are provided. Course graduates will have the state riding test waived. One weekend courses are very demanding and not for the totally inexperienced student. The Weeknight course is for the totally inexperienced student and provides extra range time on basic skills.

<u>Performance Based Course (PB)</u> A one-day course for the experienced, but unlicensed, rider to become licensed and legal. Also, many experienced, licensed riders use the PB as an annual refresher and skills tune-up. Students must provide their own motorcycle with a clutch (no scooters). This course teaches braking, turning, countersteering, speed judgment, and other techniques. All students will take a riding skills test at the beginning of the class. If a student fails this test, then he/she must enroll in the novice motorcycle course (BRC). All students must provide proof of insurance for his/her bike, and the bike must pass a safety inspection before taking the skills test.

Experienced Rider Course (ERC) A 6 hour Motorcycle Safety Foundation course for the experienced licensed rider. Emphasis is on advanced riding skills. Students must provide the motorcycle. All participants must

provide proof of motorcycle endorsement, insurance for the motorcycle, and the motorcycle must pass a safety inspection.

All students must furnish protective riding gear: D.O.T. approved motorcycle helmet; eye protection; full-finger gloves; sturdy, over-the-ankle boots, (NO TENNIS SHOES); heavy-duty pants; heavy-duty long-sleeved shirt or jacket; and rain or cold weather gear as needed. Weekend classes start Friday night at 6 p.m. and run all day Saturday and Sunday, from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. Weekday classes run 8 a.m. to 12 p.m. or 9 a.m. to 1 p.m., depending on location. Weeknight classes run 5:30 p.m. to 9:30 p.m. PBs start at 8 a.m. ERCs start at 9 a.m.


