MARCH 1ST MEETING DISCUSSION ON BIKE MIRRORS

At the meeting on March 1st, a question about mirrors to help eliminate the blind spot was raised. Below are a couple of links to the company that was mentioned, Multivex. In addition to the listed models of BMW's for which they already have mirrors, it is thought you can send them your specific measurements and they will make a mirror specific for your needs.

No affiliation, but I do have these mirrors on my R1200RT. Takes a little getting use to, but they do increase the field of view to the side.

AND TO REPEAT, DO NOT RELY ON MIRROWS WHEN MAKING ANY LANE CHANNGES. ALWAYS LOOK OVER YOUR SHOULDER TO MAKE CERTAIN THE LANE IS CLEAR, DO NOT RELY ON THE MIRROR ONLY.

I ALSO SUGGEST ALWAYS KNOWING WHERE YOU ARE IN RELATION TO TRAFFIC, BY SCANNING AHEAD, MIRRORS, ETC. ON A REGULAR 10 SECOND SCAN CYCLE.
