# **ATTENTION K1200LT OWNERS (IVES POTRAFKA)**

It was not one of BMW's better ideas when they designed the trunk mirror system in the LT. If you own a LT, I would bet that your hinges (the plastic peg) have broken more than once, that is if you replaced it the first time. My warranty covered 2 or 3 of these.

Last week, with 40K plus on the LT and the warranty long gone, the hinge broke again. So I got a little creative and fixed it myself this time. Total cost of \$3.75. I thought I would share the details of this with the other LT riders in our club.

# TOOLS NEEDED:

- Screw driver, pliers and torx driver from your tool kit.
- Dremel tool or small hack saw blade.
- Drill and small drill bit

### SUPPLIES NEEDED

- 3/4" x 5/8" brass hinge
- 8 small bolts and nuts

This is really quite simple and took about an hour, including the two trips to the hardware store figuring out what hinge would work and getting the 8th bolt that I lost between home and the hardware store.

- 1. Hold the sections in place and note the distance between the top and bottom sections.
- 2. Remove the 5 torx screws from the lower cover that holds the hinge pins of the mirror.
- 3. With the Dremel tool or fine hacksaw blade, trim of the plastic hinge arm from the mirror section. This is necessary, as the non-broken hinge pin will bind unless the new hinge is perfectly placed and you don't need it in the way anymore.
- 4. Carefully align the two sections, be sure to leave the same distance between the two parts as checked in #1.
- 5. Lay the hinge in the outside of the two sections and align as far to the outer edges as possible. The hinge size specified will fit and you will to not hit the actual mirror. But be sure to double check. I tired a couple different sizes and the  $\frac{3}{4}$  x 5/8 is the best.
  - 6. Drill the 8 holes for the bolts.
  - 7. Install the hinges.
- 8. On the inside of the sections (nut side) cut off the extra bolt with a Dremel tool or fine hacksaw blade.
  - 9. Reinstall the two sections using the 5 torx screws.
  - 10. YOU ALL DONE.....
