BMW MOA BLOOMBURG, PA RALLY

This year's BMW MOA Rally is in Bloomsburg, PA, on July 21-24, 2011. This is expected to be the largest rally in the history of the MOA. Cost per suite is \$150 and will be split evenly by the number of people in each suite. There is a kitchen in each of the suites or food can be purchased in the food court that services the University.
