Rhys B. used the club CC to make the reservation deposit of \$500 for the Winter Dinner so that came directly out of the check book balance.

Rhys B. also won \$28.00 during the 50/50 drawing at our SNOWY December Club meeting. \$11.28 was reimbursed to Rhys for donuts so the net amount added to the club funds from the 50/50 was \$44.72 Another \$40.00 was received for Membership/Associate renewals for 2014 and \$315 was received for nine reservations at the Winter Dinner.

During December, we had one member renew membership using PayPal which added only \$14.26 because of PayPal's fee when using a CC. No fees are charged the club if you send you payment from your PayPal account.

An additional two members and one associate renewed their memberships during December, taking our 2014 membership to 44.
