So hop to it, fill out the starting mileage form and then DON'T forget to complete the ending mileage form in October and mail them in...that always helps. The average mileage rider this year is from Austin, TX and he clocked 8,741. It's really not a contest. I think of it like playing golf, but more fun. Instead of doing the season in less shots, you try to do the season with more miles. It's just a fun way of planning your riding season.

By now John Saarian has the ride to Kentucky just about ready to go. June brings our club picnic and July is the MOA Rally in Minnesota, August is the annual Fried Baloney Ride to Waldo, Ohio and in September we ride to Frankenmuth for chicken and October takes us North again to Legs Inn. In between these rides are our club rides on the second Saturday of each month and weekly Betty has us dining all over Macomb, Oakland and St. Clair Counties. Now think, if you attended everyone of the above mentioned rides this year you would easily have chocked up at least 8,740 miles and ridden them with friends. Go figure.
